We are seeking a full-time (37.5 hours weekly) summer intern for a 12± week internship as a Financial Analyst. The selected candidate will be exposed to a variety of work with a focus around the following:

1. Provide accounting support to the year-end process.
2. Assist with developing and documenting the fiscal year 2022 operating plan.
3. Assist with enhancing key performance indicators (KPIs) for management and board to help evaluate the success of the Bank in meeting its performance objectives.
4. Assist with automating the month-end "GL Entry File" to update investment-related transactions including purchase and sales, accretion/amortization of discounts/premiums and change in market value from Clearwater to Intacct – the Bank's bond accounting and general ledger solutions, respectively.
5. Assist in the design and implementation of a cash management system – to document and project cash flow and forecast future sources and uses of cash.
