We are seeking a full-time (37.5 hours weekly) summer intern for a 12± week internship as a Research Analyst. The focus of this internship is to assist the Director of Stormwater and Resiliency in developing underwriting standards for assessing climate-risks posed in new loan originations. Secondly, candidates will be expected to participate in the implementation of the Infrastructure Bank’s Stormwater and Resiliency Program. Candidates will be encouraged to take on responsibilities that align with both their own personal interests and the pursuits of the organization.

An internship with the Infrastructure Bank is an exciting opportunity to gain valuable experience at the frontier of the emerging field of green banking in an innovative and supportive work environment. We are seeking candidates with a strong interest and expertise in project management, climate finance, stakeholder engagement, and green stormwater infrastructure.

- Work out of the Infrastructure Bank's office in Providence, RI (schedule negotiable)
- Adhere to all rules and regulations required of Bank staff
- Maintain a level of professionalism and integrity appropriate of a contributing member of the team and organization
