



Energy Asset Management Program

WHAT IT IS

The **Energy Asset Management Program (EAMP)** seeks to create or help progress towards municipalities energy efficiency, renewable energy, or emission reduction goals. This free program will analyze the energy usage of facilities to identify and provide pathways to reach each participant's goals.

HOW IT WORKS

Over the course of a year, representatives from the city or town, the Rhode Island Infrastructure Bank, R.I. Office of Energy Resources, and an energy consultant will:

- Collaboratively identify energy saving measures to meet the goals of the municipality at no cost
- Develop an Action Plan and identify financing opportunities to implement the measures
- Develop a tool to track energy savings post-implementation of the measures

The Energy Asset Management Program is provided to participants at no charge. Participants are expected to provide energy use data for analysis and designate 1-3 staff members to dedicate 50-100 hours to actively participate throughout the year-long program.

HOW TO APPLY

Interested participants should contact the Rhode Island Infrastructure Bank expressing interest in the program. Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
