

## Infrastructure Bank Closes On \$184 Million Bond Issue To Finance Clean Water & PFAS Remediation Projects

On February 25th, we closed on a \$184 million bond issue to finance critical infrastructure investments in clean water (Narragansett Bay Commission, \$75 million) and drinking water (Kent County Water Authority, \$25 million) projects. The bond received AAA credit ratings from both S&P Global Ratings and Fitch Ratings, reflecting strong investor confidence and the Bank's strong financial management.

This bond issue represents a major investment in the health of our environment and the safety of our drinking water. By providing low-cost financing for the Narragansett Bay Commission's historic Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) project and supporting Kent County Water Authority's efforts to tackle emerging contaminants, we are continuing to put capital to work for the benefit of Rhode Islanders. These projects are a testament to the power of utilizing the Clean Water and Drinking Water State Revolving Funds to meet the state's most pressing infrastructure needs.
